White's Memorial Presbyterian Church seeks a part-time stated supply pastor who shares our mission to lead our congregation in spiritual growth, provide pastoral care, and engage with our broader community.

DESCRIPTION OF OUR CHURCH:

We are a small but welcoming community glorifying God through ministry, mission, and service:

- Reflecting the hospitality of Christ to all.
- Worshipping together, welcoming all people, and offering meaningful spiritual experiences.
- Studying and teaching the Bible, providing a source of hope and direction for people's lives.
- Respecting individual differences and nurturing one another with prayer, support, and fellowship.
- Promoting good stewardship of God's earth and its resources, as well as our own spiritual and material gifts.
- Sharing God's love by reaching out to our neighbors locally and globally with a deep compassion
- Participating in activities that attack the causes of poverty and injustice, both here and around the world.

The community of Berea is anchored by Berea College, the first interracial and coeducational college in the South, with a strong commitment to serving Appalachia and students in need. Our church is located on the outskirts of Berea, amid rolling farmland but minutes from the town. One of the oldest churches in Berea, White's Memorial is part of a rich tradition of faith and service.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PASTOR:

The part-time stated supply pastor will lead and organize services, provide pastoral care, and engage with other faith leaders and ministries in our community.

- Lead worship and preach on Sundays plus special services (see below), including administration of sacraments on the first Sunday of each month

- Moderate Session and Congregational meetings
- Lead funeral services and weddings, upon request and with Session approval
- Attend Sunday School and Wednesday Night Fellowship when applicable and available
- Lead special services (*Christmas Eve, Ash Wednesday, Easter Sunrise*)
- Prepare weekly liturgy for Sundays when minister is in pulpit and also for special services

APPROXIMATE TIME EXPECTATION: 20 hours per week

SALARY AND BENEFITS:

- Cash salary: **\$25,000**
- Social Security: **\$2,371.50**
- Housing allowance: **\$6000** per year
- Continuing Education: **\$500** (e.g., books and other professional expenses)
- Ministry expenses reimbursed, including travel at 2026 IRS Rate (\$.72.5/mile)
- Vacation - 4 weeks/annually
- Continuing Education - Two (2) weeks per year
